

Function

Symmetrical piston/rod seals are designed to seal the pressurized hydraulic fluid against the atmosphere or between two pressurized spaces.

Features

- ⇒ Symmetrical, single acting piston/rod seal, no interference on the ID or OD.
- ⇒ Stabilisation of the sealing ring by an additional retainer ring.
- ⇒ Excellent static and dynamic sealing performance.
- ⇒ Excellent performance in low pressure conditions.
- \Rightarrow Useable for long stroke lengths.
- \Rightarrow Negligible tendency to "stick-slip" effect above a speed of 0.15 m/s.

Application

Reciprocating pistons/rods in hydraulic cylinders, plungers etc. Replacement for rubber fabric seals of older machineries. Max. pressure 400 bar, max. speed 0.5 m/s.
